

Eventually when we did leave the gym order had been established and I feel that Chief Superintendent NESBITT had established control both outside and inside the ground. I do not recall what time this would have been. Whilst in the gym it was only then that it dawned on us the serious nature of what had occurred and with the benefit of hindsight I do not feel there was enough medical provision available.

We left the ground and I drove Acting Superintendent BATES back to West Bar Police Station via the Charge Office.

I have no recollection of any request for Ambulance and Fire or implementation of the Major Incident Plan.

Prior to this day I would say I had good knowledge of Hillsborough Stadium from policing events there previously over many years as a constable and sgt.

Once back at West Bar news kept coming in regarding the number of deceased.

I did not attend any debrief prior to going off duty later that evening.

I think welfare support was offered to staff within a few days and it was something which they could opt into.

Regarding my welfare, Acting Superintendent BATES and I discussed what we had seen and done that day.

I was aware of the Match Commanders for the day due to my involvement in planning. I was not aware that ACC JACKSON was present at the ground until later after the event.

I had no knowledge or involvement in the PNC checks that were carried out on the deceased.

PREVIOUS SEMI-FINALS – I do believe I would have worked at the previous semi final matches but I have no recollection of anything significant occurring.
