

are occupied by supporters of the same team. When establishing the height we have considered that the views to the corner flags should not be restricted any further than they are at present by the perimeter fence. We therefore propose that the top of the fence should be approximately 1680mm above the terrace.

This may not prevent the odd spectator climbing the fence but should eliminate a mass invasion from one area to the other. Fences this height appear to work successfully at St. James's Park, the home of Newcastle United.

We would be pleased if this specific point can be discussed within the Working Party and your comments forwarded to us.

Also to be included in the same contract are some gates at various locations around the north stand. Now the gymnasium is open to the general public security to other parts of the ground must be maintained. It is proposed that gates are provided at the top of the ramps at both ends of the stand with additional gates at ground floor level at the Penistone Road end of the stand. A separate gate will be placed behind the west ramp to prevent people going round the rear of the gymnasium towards Leppings Lane.
