particular area if the ground was packed with spectators. He felt that a higher fence than the present one or a double fence was necessary. I suggested that we should have a double fence with a gap between so as to keep the spectators apart and to provide a space in which his officers could stand. Fewer policemen would be needed if the spectators had a gap between them. It so happens that right alongside the existing fence there is a gate on to the pitch and if the second fence were placed on the other side of the gate, it will provide an easy access gangway for the police and they will be able to move in and out of the gap depending on the situation. Mr. Moseley was clearly very pleased by this suggestion and subject to your approval, we are including the work in the contract for segregating the spectators at Leppings Lane end.

I should point out that it will mean losing about a metre of advertising space because the hoardings carry straight on past that particular gate at present. There will have to be a gap in the hoardings to enable the police to get in and out and of course, to evacuate the crowd in emergency.
